- 1.2 line spacing
- Times New Roman
- Left-aligned
- Pagination at the head of the page and centered
- Margins are as follows: Top and Bottom: 2,5 cm; Left and Right: 2,5 cm.

Paper (Times New Roman, 12, left-aligned)

References (Times New Roman, 11, left-aligned)

- One blank line is left after the paper title, authors' names and before headings in the text; two lines are left after authors' affiliation/address
- Headings (Times New Roman, 12, bold); one blank line before headings
- Please include an abstract before the text of the paper (maximum of 300 words; Times New Roman, 11, *italic*, centre justified)
- Please include 3 - 5 keywords after the abstract.
- Illustrations are placed within text of the paper.
- Use footnotes, not endnotes.
- Please submit papers completely prepared for the website-publication. The total length of the text, including footnotes and references but excluding figures is limited to 8.000 words in pages of A4 format. Minimum length is 4.500 words.

- The paper should be sent in a single pdf file, including figures, tables and images, and without links.
- Texts are typed in MS Word version 6 or above (12 point Times New Roman, 1.2 line spacing).

References

References should be indicated in the typescript by giving the author's name and the year of publication, as follows: (Parsons, 1994).

If several papers by the same author and from the same year are cited, a, b, c, etc. should be put after the year of publication. The references should be listed in full at the end of the paper in the following standard form:
